OVERNIGHT RATES-SITE STAFF PROVIDED MEALS: 25 Person Minimum

The following facilities are included: Indoor Chapel (if available), Outdoor Chapel, Recreation Hall, playground equipment, and the campfire circles.

Meals are provided by site food service.

1 Night-\$13.00 plus 3 Meals-\$25.50 for a total of \$38.50 per person

2 Nights or more \$12.00 per night per person plus meals:

Breakfast-\$7.00

Lunch-\$8.50

Dinner-\$10.00

Snack-\$3.50

The minimum of 25 meals or the number you communicate to the Site Director two weeks before your scheduled arrival will be prepared. Guests dining in excess of the number indicated will be billed at the current rates.

OVERNIGHT RATES-SELF PROVIDED MEALS:

The following facilities are included: Kitchen with refrigeration and ice, Indoor Chapel (if available), Outdoor Chapel, Recreation Hall, playground equipment, and the campfire circles. ***Cold meal prep is included.***

A kitchen use fee of \$135 per day or \$50 per meal will apply with the use of any cooking appliances.

1 Night-\$13.00 per person, minimum charge of \$325.00 (25 person minimum)

2 Nights or more \$12.00 per night per person, minimum charge of \$650.00

RETREAT CABIN - 1 Night: \$65.00/cabin. 2 bedrooms (sleep 4 each), living room, kitchenette and ¾ bath. **2 Nights+:** \$60.00/cabin

INFIRMARY CABIN – 3 bedrooms (2 single rooms, 1 room sleeping 4). Same rates as retreat cabin

DISCOUNT POLICY

Church groups from the Susquehanna Annual Conference of the United Methodist Church, who have paid their Shares of Ministry in full in the previous year, are eligible for a 10% discount on lodging or facility rental.

Agencies of SUSUMC are also eligible for a 10% discount on lodging or facility rental. This discount will be reflected on the invoice for the event.

DEPOSITS

For the **LODGES**, a deposit of \$325.00 must accompany the completed reservation form.

For the **RETREAT CABIN**, a deposit fee of \$65.00 must accompany the completed reservation form.

DAY USE and WEDDING RESERVATIONS must be paid in full at the time the reservation is placed.

Completed reservation form and deposit must be received in the Camping Office within 15 days of initial reservation request. If the deposit is not received in that period of time, another group may make a reservation for that facility.

TENTATIVE HOLD POLICY

Please note that we have a two week tentative hold policy. We will not continue to hold your tentative reservation beyond the two week period without a completed application and deposit. Tentative holds cannot be re-applied to a date once the initial 2 week grace period has expired.

REFUND POLICY

Deposits are refundable (minus a \$50.00 processing fee) when cancellations are received 90 days prior to the scheduled arrival. Cancellations received less than 90 days prior to the event will result in the forfeiture of the full deposit. If the cancellation is received less than 45 days prior to the event, your group will be billed for one half the total cost of the event, minus your deposit.

DAMAGE POLICY

All damages (including graffiti) will be assessed and billed to the group at the rate of cost of repair and/or replacement.

INSURANCE

Incorporated groups not related to the Susquehanna Annual Conference of The United Methodist Church are required to submit to the Office of Camping and Retreats a *Certificate of Insurance* prior to their arrival on the site. Non-incorporated groups are hereby notified that any individual claim for accidents, illness or dental is the sole responsibility of the individual, and will need to be submitted for payment to his/her personal health insurance.
